

Constitution

of the Eta Mu chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi
San Diego State University

Preamble

Be it known that the Eta Mu Chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi, National Fraternity for band members, is hereby established with the intent of furthering the cause of band music in general and the San Diego State University bands in particular; furthermore, that this chapter shall combine its resources with the Zeta Xi chapter of Tau Beta Sigma towards that end, yet remain distinct in identity and ritual.

Article I - Purposes

1. The purposes of this chapter shall be listed in the Joint Bylaws of Kappa Kappa Psi and Tau Beta Sigma at San Diego State University (the "joint chapter bylaws").

Article II – General

1. The chapter shall be governed jointly by this Constitution, the joint chapter bylaws, and the National Constitution of Kappa Kappa Psi.
2. The members of this chapter shall meet during combined meetings with the members of the Zeta Xi chapter of Tau Beta Sigma.
3. All decisions of this chapter shall be made during the combined meetings set forth above, and subject to the provisions of the joint chapter bylaws. Separate business meetings shall not occur without the prior approval of the Chapter Sponsor.

Article III – Membership

1. All aspects of membership in this chapter, including the Membership Education Program, shall be governed by the National Constitution of Kappa Kappa Psi, with any additional stipulations and provisions as specified in the joint chapter bylaws.
2. Matters of membership status in Kappa Kappa Psi shall be voted on by members of Kappa Kappa Psi.

Article IV – Officers

1. Officers of Kappa Kappa Psi shall be elected by the active members of Kappa Kappa Psi. Office positions, requirements, and the election scheduling process shall be as defined in the joint chapter bylaws.

Article V – Finances

1. All finances shall be held in common with the Zeta Xi chapter of Tau Beta Sigma, as specified in the joint chapter bylaws.

Article VI – Amendments

1. Amendments to this Constitution may be proposed, with previous notice, at any properly called meeting of the combined chapters and shall require a two-thirds favorable vote of the entire membership of this chapter to pass. However, such amendments shall not take effect until either:
 - a. at least one week has passed and the Chapter Sponsor has subsequently given his or her written approval of the change, or
 - b. a meaningfully identical change to the respective part of the Constitution of the Zeta Xi chapter of Tau Beta Sigma has passed.
